As the five daughters of a wonderfully caring and loving mom, the Bigane girls knew they had to plan something special for their mom's 80th birthday. Determining something special was going to be easier than they thought.

The Bigane family has been part of the Mother McAuley community for over 30 years. The five girls, Anne '76, Katie '78, Sheila '79, Meg '82, and Julie '84, are all alumnae of the school. Their mom, Mrs. Edward Bigane, has played an active role in the community since Anne was a freshman. She volunteered her time in various ways, participated in the Mothers Club (including a term as President), working in the bookstore and helping run fund-raisers, and she is still an active member of the Alumnae Mothers Club's monthly bridge group. After a few months of thinking what to give their mother for her 80th birthday, they came up with the perfect gift. They thought what better gift than to give back to McAuley on behalf of their mom.

Anne and Julie attended the Alumnae Association's Annual Putt & Party golf outing last summer and heard Dr. Christine Melone speak about the financial distress that many of our current seniors are facing. This hit home for the sisters.

"My parents felt very strongly about giving their five girls a Catholic education at Mother McAuley," says Julie. "Their dedication to put all five of us through McAuley allowed us to get a top-quality education, make lifelong friends and do whatever we set our minds to. Through my parents and Mother McAuley, I learned that generosity is something that we must pay forward. In honoring our Mom, we are paying it forward to the next generation of McAuley girls in hopes that someday they will do the same."

Meg, who worked at McAuley for 13 years as an English teacher and Freshman Dean, contacted McAuley's Development Office. From there, they reached out to their entire extended family and close family friends.

"To be honest, it really wasn't much work," said Sheila. "A few phone calls and e-mails with the school, reaching out to family and friends, and collecting the donations was most of the legwork. Keeping the gift a surprise from my mom was probably the hardest part!"

They planned a small get-together with family and friends to celebrate Mrs. Bigane's birthday. It was at this celebration that they presented their mom with their gift.

"I was stunned. I had no clue," said Mrs. Bigane. "At 80, there isn't much you want or need anymore. If anything, you are trying to give everything away! So to receive a gift that will allow girls to have the education, experiences and opportunities my daughters had was just wonderful."

When asked how their McAuley experience helped influence them and shape who they are today, the Bigane girls all agreed that empowerment was a great word to answer this question. They said they all left McAuley with the mind-set that there was nothing they could not do. McAuley gave them self-confidence and leadership skills, prepared them for college, and provided the support that allowed them to succeed in life. Sister Cathleen Cahill, Sister Ruth Mutchler, and Sister Corinne Raven are just a few of the role models they mention that helped shape these skills. The opportunity to allow other girls to have this experience was something the Bigane family could not pass up.

"When Julie first came up with the idea I loved it," said Meg. "I

thought what better way to say thank you to our parents by honoring our mom for providing us with a McAuley education and all the experiences that came with it. This gift will allow other girls to have those same opportunities we had. We can pay it forward." Sheila said, "It was our mom's George Bailey moment!"

The Bigane family and friends raised money that will be dedicated to tuition assistance as well as helping current seniors receive the full McAuley experience. The fund may be used not just for tuition but for graduation expenses, retreat costs and senior activities.

The nearly 200 supporters donned tiaras and sashes as they watched Erin live on national television.

"This was a unique opportunity to not only celebrate Erin, but to raise money for McAuley. Erin is very supportive of Mother McAuley and it was a thrill to watch her in the pageant," said Suzie McKeon, president of the Alumnae Board.

Although Erin was not crowned Miss America, the event was a success nonetheless. The event, sponsored by the McAuley Alumnae Association, Mothers Club and Fathers Club, brought people together to raise money for school improvements.

To tie into the pageant theme, 53 sashes representing each Miss America contestant were sold. Sash bearers could follow along with their contestant during the pageant with the lucky top five states receiving a prize. Betty Reynolds Fell '78 won the grand prize of Chicago Bulls tickets when her contestant, Miss Virginia Caressa Cameron,



was crowned Miss America. Other evening events included a silent auction, raffles, and games of chance.

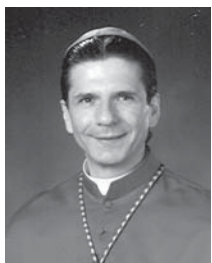

A member of the Missionaries of the Holy Spirit since 1973, Bishop Garcia-Siller was ordained in 1984 and was elevated to bishop seven years ago.

As a recipient of the Catherine McAuley Leadership Award, the school pays tribute to Bishop Garcia-Siller and his support of the mission of the school in providing a quality Catholic liberal arts education for young women.

For more than three decades, Laura Shallow has supported Mother McAuley High School's mission. Most recently

## McAuley students build biodiesel processor to help Haitian school

When McAuley Science Chairperson Dr. Roz Iasillo proposed to the students in the EcoMacs Club that they should build a biodiesel processor, no one could have predicted how significant this project would be to the students of two schools, thousands of miles apart.

"The goal of the EcoMacs Club was to build a biodiesel processor that would run on solar energy, use natural resources and send it to the Lakal Pa Nou School in Pichon, Haiti," said Iasillo.

The natural resource is the seed of the jatropha plant, which grows abundantly in Haiti. The solar-powered processor will heat the oil-rich seeds of the jatropha plant which will be extracted, mixed with Methoxide and agitated in order to separate the glycerin byproduct from the oil. Once the glycerin is removed, the pure biodiesel fuel created can be used by farmers in their

tractors to grow jatropha.

Cindy Goren from Michigan State University College of Engineering and Education for Prosperity Co-founder Pierre Balthazar, a native of Haiti, are acting as advisors for the McAuley group. Education for Prosperity founded the Lekol Pa Nou (which means "Our School") ten years ago. Any excess energy generated by the solar panels for the biodiesel processor will be used to provide electricity for the school.

The glycerin byproduct will also generate a source of income for the village. It can be used as fertilizer and made into soap which can be sold. Additionally, the biodiesel fuel can be used in oil lamps.

After the earthquake, the McAuley students quickly learned that the Haitian school was safe but plans to ship the processor over spring break would have to be put on hold. Dr. Iasillo will travel to Haiti in April to do some preparation work, to visit with the people of Pichon, and to see the McAuley Jatropha Farm that has recently been established.

## **Alumnae Carolling**

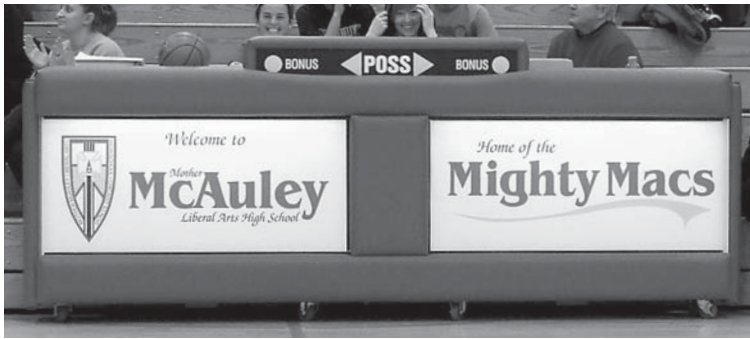

## McAuley Adds Lacrosse Team to List of Athletic Sports

President/Principal Dr. Christine Melone and Athletic Director Laurie Jakubczak '78 are pleased to announce the addition of lacrosse to McAuley's athletics program starting in the 2010-11 academic year. It's the first sport added at McAuley since golf began in 2002.

In October, the Illinois High School Association (IHSA) announced that it had elected to add lacrosse to their official list of high school sports for both boys and girls in 2011. McAuley will begin their lacrosse program this year by offering JV and Freshmen club teams.

"Lacrosse is a growing sport, particularly in the past 10 years," said Jakubczak. "As the only all-girls school in the area to be adopting the sport, adding lacrosse not only offers more opportunities for our student-athletes, but will open doors for future students interested in the sport as well."

With the addition of lacrosse, McAuley now offers its student-athletes twelve sports to choose from including basketball, cross country, diving, golf, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis, track and field, volleyball, and water polo.

The new lacrosse coach is Class of 1995 alumna Ann Burns O'Neill who will be assisted by Hilary Sterk '05 and Emily Drown.

"I was extremely excited when I heard McAuley was adding lacrosse," said O'Neill. "Having played lacrosse at U of I, I know it will be a great fit for McAuley."

According to the Illinois High School Women's Lacrosse Association, the appeal of lacrosse has risen tremendously with more players being recognized nationally and continuing on to play at the college level.
